

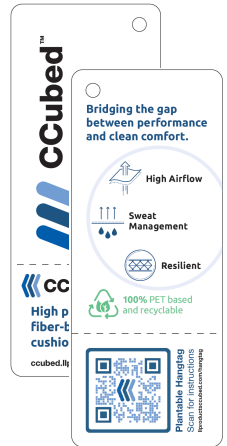
How to plant seed paper.

CCubed™ is our innovative cushioning material that outperforms traditional foam and other nonwovens in moisture management and breathability while maintaining effective resiliency. CCubed™ is 100% PET based and can be recycled enabling our customers to have a circular solution. Our display hangtags are embedded with annual and perennial wildflower seeds.

1. Loosen the soil
2. Soak the seed paper in water overnight
3. Plant the wet seed paper in the prepared soil, at a depth of about 1/4"
4. Water well, especially during the first four to six weeks
5. Practice weed control

WHEN TO PLANT

- Plant the paper outdoors in the cooler months, fall through early spring. Fall plantings will take advantage of the winter rains to give you early spring blooms.
- Plant anytime indoors, then transplant to a more permanent location in early spring.
- Perennials will not usually bloom the first year but your annuals will.
